WHAT'S S.E.A.R.C.H.?

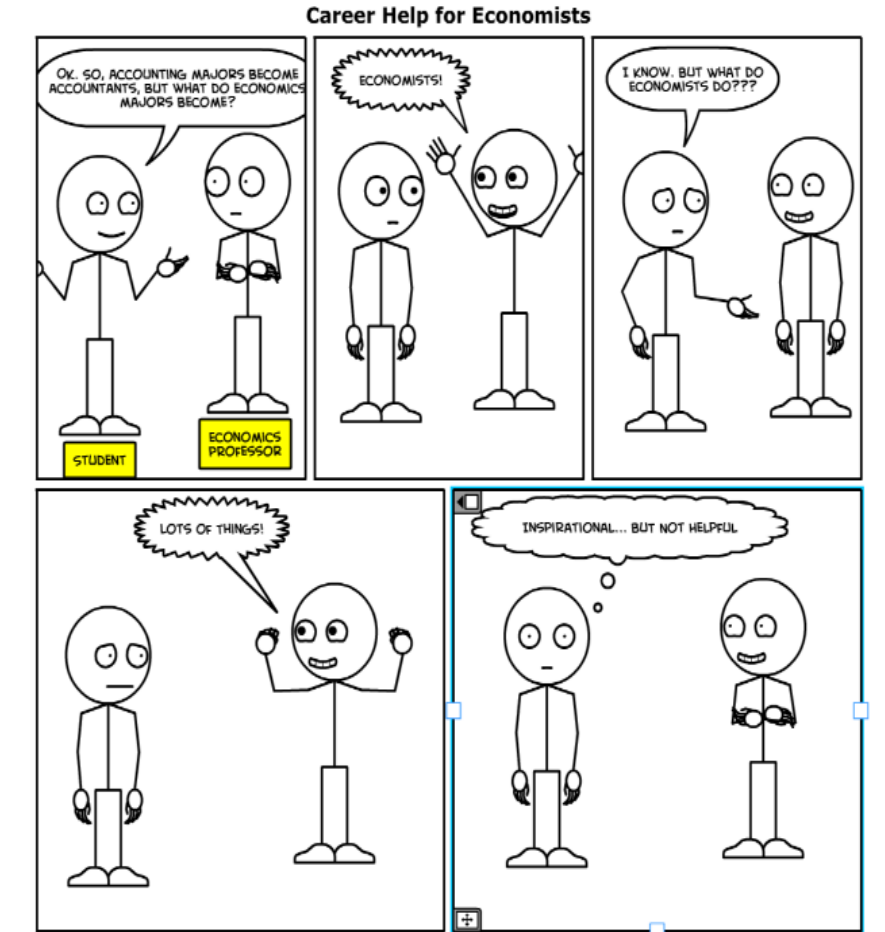
S.E.A.R.C.H. is a new group intended for declared economics majors and minors who are serious about exploring their career options. Members are welcome (and encouraged) to join as soon as they declare their major or minor. Early career planning is key to finding the job you want when you graduate. Throughout the fall and spring semesters S.E.A.R.C.H. will hold a series of events including.

- Discussions with economists working in industry.
- Meetings with recruiters from area businesses interested in hiring our graduates.
- Interview and resume coaching.
- FAQ sessions for those interested in graduate school – professional and PhD programs.
- One-on-One career focused advising for majors starting junior year.

Meeting dates and times will be varied to try to accommodate busy schedules.

DO I HAVE TO BE AN ECONOMICS MAJOR OR MINOR?

S.E.A.R.C.H. will welcome students who are not declared majors and minors for up to 1 semester as *Browsing Members*. While browsing, you will have access to resources posted for our S.E.A.R.C.H. members and will be invited to attend events subject to availability.
